Under the leadership of Michael Kearns, members perform authentic and challenging repertoire that balances tradition in jazz with innovation in big band writing. With various skill sets and experience levels, the emphasis is on the ensemble's sound and how each member can be inspired to continue his/her own music education. The AHBB serves to inform, entertain, and unite fans of jazz and keep the big band tradition alive.

The After Hours Big Band continues to thrill audiences at concerts and festivals in Ontario, such as the Newmarket Music Festival, Aurora Jazz+ Music Festival, the Unionville Big Band Festival, and numerous private events and fund-raisers in the York Region.

Michael currently teaches music and the liberal arts at Georgian College and performs trombone with the Octokats.
